Control Measures to be adopted to ensure a safe system of work (procedures, restrictions, personal protective equipment and other precautions)		
Minimum provision of personal protective equipment id appropriate. Keep material in original container and close when not in use. For hygienic requirements wash hands before eating and clothes if contaminated.		
Checks that must be undertaken before the work commences and maintenance requirements for facilities:		
Check that the material containers are in good condition and not leaking. Ensure that soak up materials are available such as dry sand or vermiculite.		
Disposal procedure for hazardous chemicals:		
Disposal through licensed waste handling contractor.		
Emergency action in the case of spillage or uncontrolled release:		
Use sand, vermiculite or other similar material to absorb spillage and flush area with water. Prevent from entering soil or drains.		
Emergency action in the case of fire:		
Use chemical powder or foam extinguisher not direct water stream. Professional fire-fighting services should wear self-contained breathing apparatus and prevent contact with skin.		
Emergency First aid (ingestion, inhalation, skin/eye contact):		
Inhalation: Remove to fresh air. Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting and drink solution of baking powder and water. Call physician. Skin: Flush with soap and plenty of clean water Eyes: Promptly wash eyes with plenty of clean water for 30 minutes Consult physician if an discomfort persist.
